

PROJECT TEAM VOLUNTEER INFORMATION

The Milton Keynes Rose is situated in Campbell Park. It is a unique artwork involving several pillars which are inscribed with dates and events which are important to the people of Milton Keynes.

The Milton Keynes Rose Trust is an independent charity which works in partnership with The Parks Trust to manage the Rose.

The Trust is supported by our volunteers, who play a vital role in our community engagement. Our volunteers work in the Project Team, whose purpose is to organise events and support other organisations who wish to hold events at the Rose.

The Project Team typically meets every 2 weeks on Monday mornings (11 a.m. to about 12.30) at The Parks Trust Pavilion, 1300 Silbury Boulevard, MK9 4AD - but the day, the time and the frequency could all be reviewed. Whilst we encourage meetings wherever possible in person, it is also possible to attend the meetings remotely.

If you are interested in joining the Project Team, we would particularly welcome volunteers with the following skills or experience:

- Experience of planning and organising events
- Knowledge of local groups who can assist in events at the Rose – choirs, speakers, bands, dance groups, etc

- Ability to manage events at minimum cost
- Experience of using social media and interested in leading our communications and marketing of events at the Rose
- Willingness to attend and help at events at the Rose.
